

Sugar Skull Bracelet & Earrings Instructions

What's In Your Kit

- 10 Sugar Skull beads
- Size 8 seed beads three colors
- 1 5mm jump ring
- .019 diameter Soft Flex beading wire Satin Silver
- 2 earwires
- 3 headpins
- 2 crimps
- 1 toggle clasp



I fell in love with these funky sugar skull beads and I hope you will too! Enjoy! Love, Jill

Step 1 – String the bracelet

On one end of the wire, string a crimp bead and one half of the clasp. Go back through the crimp bead and tighten the wire. Crimp the crimp bead.

String 3 seed beads (you get to decide which ones to use in which order!) and a skull bead. Repeat until you reach the length you desire (minus the length of the toggle clasp.) End with 3 seed beads.

Then string a crimp bead and one half of the clasp. Go back through the crimp bead and tighten the wire. Check your length at this point – before you crimp. Once you are satisfied, crimp the crimp bead.

Step 2 – Create the dangle

String a seed bead, a skull bead, and a seed bead on a headpin, and create a simple wrapped loop on top using round nose pliers. Trim the excess using flush cutters. Then attach to the clasp aread using a jump ring.

Step 3 – Create earrings

String a seed bead, a skull bead, and a seed bead on a headpin, and create a simple wrapped loop on top using round nose pliers. Trim the excess using flush cutters. Then attach to the clasp aread using a jump ring.
