


## **Skinny Two-Hole Herringbone**


This is meant to be supplemental to the full set of Two-Hole Herringbone instructions.


**Row 1** – pick up 1 seed bead and 1 two-hole bead, and 3 seed beads.

(The X is to tell you to ignore this bead. Pretend it's not there. I don't want to have to take the photos all over again.)



Pass through the top hole of the two-hole bead.






**Row 2** – pick up 1 seed bead and 1 two-hole bead. Pass through the seed bead from the previous row.

Flip work.




**Row 3** – Pick up 2 seed bead and pass through the second hole of the two-hole bead from the previous row.



Pick up 1 seed bead and 1 two-hole bead. Pass through the two seed beads from the previous row.

Flip work.



Repeat Row 3 until you have the length desired!
