Minos® Opaque Pistachio et Opaque Indian Peach

Puca®

Made by Puca





Materials (17 cm bracelet) :

- 8 Minos par Puca® (10 for bangle)
- 6 gr de Delicas DB11/0 (DB11)
- 3 gr seed beads 11/0 (SB11)
- 2 gr seed beads 15/0 (SB15)
- 16 bicons 3 mm (B3) (20 B3 for a closed bangle)
- 1 clasp
- 2 jump rings
- Fireline 0.12



1) Add the first bead that will be used as stopper.



2) String 11 DB11, 1 SB11, 15 DB11.



3) Add the number of beads like in the photo.



4) Working in peyote stitch, add 1 row using the same pattern.



5) Make another row adding now 2 SB11.



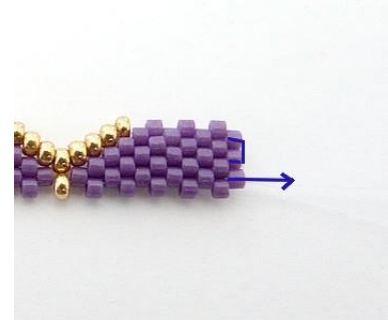
6) Add another row, skipping one SB11 by passing through the SB's11.



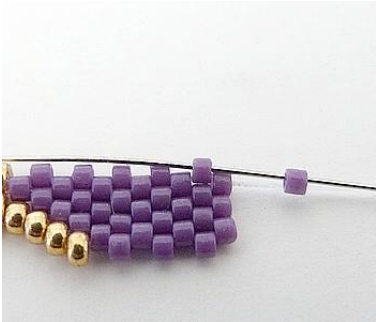
7) Repeat step 6.



8) Repeat step 6 once again.



9) Go out through the last DB11.



10) Continue by adding a new row.



11) Repeat steps 5 to 8



12) You will have this.



13) String 3 DB, 1 SB11



14) String 1B3, 1 SB15, 1 Minos, 1 SB15, 1 B3 and pass through the SB11.



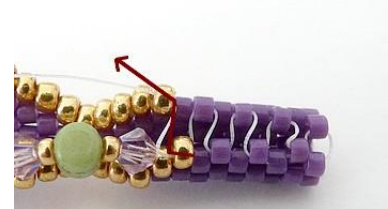
15) String 1 SB11



16) String 2 DB11, 1 SB11. Repeat steps 14 to 16.



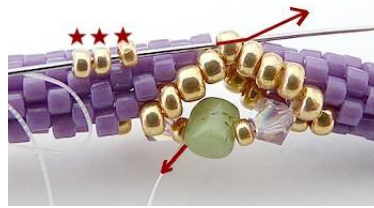
17) Go out through the last DB11.



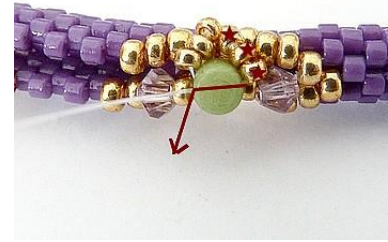
18) Fold your beadwork and start to zip it.



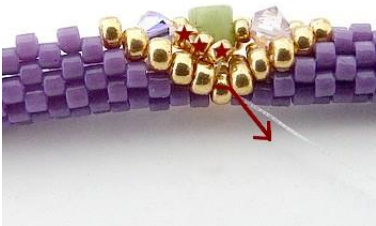
19) Pass through the B3, SB15 and Minos



20) String 3 SB15 and go out through the SB11 (middle).



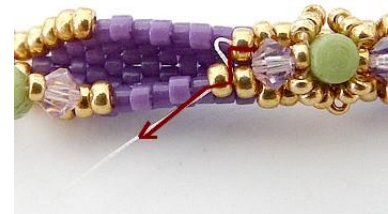
21) String 3 SB15 and go out through Minos.



22) String 3 SB15 and pass through the SB11 (middle)



23) String 3 SB15 then pass through Minos, SB15 and go out through B3.



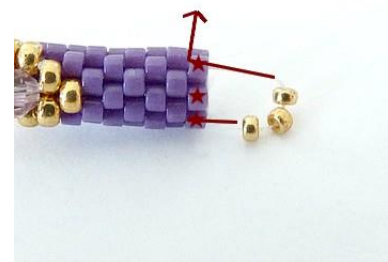
24) Zip two SB11.



25) Zip the DBs. Repeat steps 18 to 25.



26) You will have this.



27) At the end add 3 SB15 through 3 DBs.



28) Repeat step 27, strengthens and go out through the SB15 (middle).



29) Add a jump ring in the hollow and connect the two central SB15s.



30) Add the clasp

To make the bangle, just do 10 sequences of 15 DB11 and 1 R11 and close. Do steps 4 to 26. For the necklace I do sequences of 25 DB11
