Material:

- 1 x14mm cabochon par Puca®
- 4 Arcos® par Puca®
- 2 Amos® par Puca®
- 2 gr. Delicas 11/0 (DB11)
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11), 8/0 (R8)
- 2 rings Ø 4mm
- 1 Chain 20 cm – 1 stop bead



- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 36 DB11 and close



2) You can place your work in a pen



3) Bead 5 DB11 rows



4) Bead 2 R15 rows



5) Turn work over, place your cabochon and exit like picture



6) Bead 2 R15 rows, exit through 3rd DB row



7) Pick up 1 Arcos, 1 R15, 1 R8, 1 R15 and pass through 2nd hole of Arcos



8) Pick up 1 Amos like picture



9) Repeat step 7



10) Exit through 4th DB



11) Pick up 1 R15 between the next 5 DB



12) Repeat step 7



13) Pick up 1 Amos, repeat step 7 and exit through 4th DB



14) Pick up 5 R15 like step 11. Exit through Arcos



15) Pick up 1 R15, pass through the 3 following seed beads



16) Pick up 1 R15, pass through Arcos and exit through second hole of Amos



17) Pick up 5 R15, 1 R8, 5 R15 and exit through Amos and then through Arcos



18) Pick up 1 R15, pass through the 3 following seed beads, add 1 R15, pass through Arcos, DB and R15



19) Between each R15, pick up 1 R11 and exit through Arcos. Repeat steps 15 to 19 and close your work



20) You'll now have this 😊



21) Place your chain with rings
