Material : Bracelet 17 cm

- 12 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
- 32 Arcos® par Puca®- Paris
- 1 Cabochon® par Puca®- Paris 18 mm
- 4 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- 8 Bicones 4 mm (B4)
- 2 g Delicas (DB11)
- 2 Cymbals (Kolympos) or Seed beads 8/0 (SB8)
- Seed beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 1 Clasp
- 2 Jump rings 4 mm ø
- Fireline 0.12



1) Insert 46 DB11 and close



2) Make 5 rounds of DB11 in peyote



3) Make 2 rounds with SB15



4) Turn over your work. Exit the thread HERE and insert your cabochon



5) Make 2 rounds with the SB15. Exit the thread HERE in the third round of DB11



6) Insert 1 Arcos, 7 SB15 pass in the Arcos and exit through the third DB11 of the same round



7) Insert 1 SB15, 3 Piros, 1 SB15 in the third DB11



8) Repeat steps 6 and 7 alternately.

Here is the result 😊
Exit HERE from SB15



9) Insert 1 B4 into the second hole of the Piros



10) Insert twice 1 SB11 between the two Piros



11) Insert 1 B4 into the SB15. Repeat steps 9 to 11 throughout the round. Exit through the sixth SB15



12) Insert 1 SB11, 2 Arcos and 1 SB11 into the same 5 central SB15. Strengthen the work !



13) Here is the result 😊
Exit through the SB11
HERE



14) Insert 1 SB15, 1 B3, 1 SB15 through the Arcos



15) Insert 1 SB11 and 2 Arcos. Repeat the step five times



16) Insert 3 SB15, 1 Cymbal (or SB8) and 3 SB15 into the two Arcos



17) Insert 1 SB11 between the two Arcos and exit through the Arcos HERE



18) Insert 1 SB15, 1 B3 and 1 SB15 through the SB11.

Reinforce the work by passing through all the beads (steps 15 to 18). Repeat the steps to the other side of the bracelet. Insert the clasp 😊



19) You have finished your bracelet « Oméga »



20) Another color 😊
