

MINI-ME HOOP-STAR EARRINGS

Being inside a smaller hoop does not dim their star power.

Skill level: Confident beginner and up **Techniques:** Stitching with two-hole beads

Finished length: 11/4"

MATERIALS

- 0.25 grams size 15° seed beads
- 24 size 11° seed beads
- 12 GemDuos
- 24 SuperDuos
- 2 size 30mm ear hoops with inner top loop
- 1 pair of ear wires
- 6lb. Fireline™
- Size 11 beading needle
- Scissors/Pliers



TIPS

- Check that all holes of any two-hole beads are clear before stitching.
- Be careful not to skip any beads when retracing a thread path.
- Second thread paths are not shown in the illustrations.

COMPONENT

FIGURE 1

Step 1 (red thread). Thread 26-inches of Fireline on a needle. String six GemDuos. Sew through all the GemDuos again to form a circle, and knot threads leaving a small tail. Sew away from the knot through one bead and step up by reversing direction through the open hole of the same GemDuo. Weave in and trim the tail.

Step 2 (black thread). String one 15°, one SuperDuo, one 15°, one SuperDuo and one 15°. Sew through open hole of the next GemDuo. Repeat five more times. Sew through all the beads again and exit the first 15° added in this step.

ATTACH COMPONENT TO HOOP FIGURE 2

Step 3. Position the component inside the earring hoop with a pair of SuperDuos lined up directly underneath the inside loop. **NOTE:** Make sure that the GemDuos are right side up before stitching.

Step 4 (black thread). String two 15° and sew through the open hole of the SuperDuo. String two 15°s and one 11°. Going from the front to the back, sew through the loop and back through the 11°. String two 15°s and sew through the next SuperDuo. String two 15°s and sew through the next 15°, GemDuo and 15°.

Step 5 (red thread). String two 15° and sew through the next SuperDuo. String two 15°s and one 11°. Going from the front to the back, sew over the hoop and back through the 11°. String two 15°s and sew through the next SuperDuo. String two 15°s and sew through the next 15°, GemDuo and 15°.

Step 6. Repeat Step 5 four more times. Continue through to exit the first two 15°s added in Step 4.

Step 7. Following the existing thread path, sew through the following beads: two 15°s, the 11°, the loop and back through the same 11°, the next two 15°s, SuperDuo and one 15°.

Step 8. String one 11° and sew through the next 15° and SuperDuo. Continue through the next seven beads making sure to sew into the 11°, around the hoop and back through the same 11°.

Step 9. Repeat Step 8 five more times. Secure the thread within the beadwork and trim the excess.

Step 10. Use pliers to attach an ear wire to the outside loop of the earring hoop.

Make your second earring!





Matte velvet dark teal – SuperDuos Backlit aquasol – GemDuos Metallic dark blue iris – size 15° rounds Silver lined teal – size 11° round





Matte velvet mustard – SuperDuos Backlit tequila – GemDuos Duracoat galv dark berry – size 15° rounds Duracoat op dyed kumquat – size 11° rounds

Matte velvet lizard green – SuperDuos Backlit hazel sun – GemDuos Dark blue lined green AB – size 15° rounds Duracoat galv dark mint green– size 11° rounds
