INTRODUCTION

Light snow fall flurries leave a light dusting of winter kisses on our evergreen trees in this warm, winter jewelry design. The earth tones and stripes add a retro vibe. What a cool way to sit by the fire with a warm tea or coffee and brush up on our peyote stitch skills. Join us for this 2-drop, odd-count adventure that works up as quickly as the snow accumulates!

This step-by-step tutorial is accompanied by a how-to video guide, pattern chart, word chart, and this refresher on odd-count peyote stitch. Check out pages 5-8 for the charts.



THE STITCH


The stitch worked in this design is a 2-drop, odd-count peyote. In this stitch, two beads are worked with as one.


Step 1. Cut a comfortable wingspan of beading thread. Thread on a beading needle. Leaving a 15-inch tail, string the beads that make up rows 1 and 2, which are (10) Color A. See Diagram 1. You may wish to add a stop bead.

Step 2. String the first two beads of Row 3, which are (2)A. Skip the last two beads strung in Step 1. Pass through the next two beads (working back towards the tail thread). See Diagram 2.

Step 3. String (2)A. Skip the next two beads and pass through the last four beads. Pull to tighten. The beads will pop into the brick-like position of peyote stitch. See Diagram 3.


Step 4. To add the last two beads of Row 3, you'll need to perform an odd-count turn. String (2)A. Pass back through the next four beads. Make a turn and come up through the next four. See Diagram 4. Make another turn to pass back through the two beads added in this step. See Diagram 5.





Step 6. Begin Row 5. Referring to the word chart, you'll note the first addition of the pattern bead colors. The first two sets of two beads work into the up beads as normal. See Diagram 7.

An odd-count turn is required to accomplish the addition of the last two beads of this row and to get into position to start the next row. See Diagrams 7 and 8.



WORKING THE DESIGN

Continue to create the remaining rows, referring to the word chart (pages 6-8), or pattern chart (page 5) if preferred.

ADDING THREAD

If you need to add thread, leave the old working thread in place to mark your position. Weave in a new strand, making turns until the tail stops moving when pulled.

Weave to exit from the position of the old working thread. Begin to create new rows with the new working thread. After creating several rows, weave the old working thread up into the new rows and trim.

LENGTH

Work your bracelet to your desired length. The pattern will give you a beaded length before clasp of 6.25 inches.

If you wish to add repeats to the pattern, you can go back to row 27 in the word chart and repeat through row 56, which is one repeat of the tree and stripe and will add about an inch each repeat.

FINISHING THE BRACELET

Weave to exit from the next up bead (the first bead in the last pair of Delicas added). Add two beads and pass through the next up beads (see Diagram 9). Pass through the next 2 beads below the ones just added.

Weave to exit from the beads just added. From here, ladder stitch out stacks of two Delica beads (see Diagram 10).

Ladder out a total of five stacks of two. See Diagram 11. Fold the tab you've created back over the piece.

Ladder stitch this tab to the back side of the bracelet. Attach a jump ring and clasp to the folded over tab. See photo below.

Repeat this step on the starting side. You'll first need to add one row of all Color A, then follow the steps in Diagrams 9 through 11 to create a fold over tab. Add a chain or jump rings.

Enjoy the beautiful bracelet you've created!







