RISING SUN EARRINGS

Let's use Delica beads and 15/0s to create fun earrings reminiscent of shining suns.

We'll use peyote stitch to bezel a chaton and add embellishment to hold the stone inside a Quick Links ring.

Enjoy playing with colour to create different effects with this versatile project.



SUPPLY LIST

- Size 11/0 Miyuki Delicas in 3 colors (less than 0.5g of each)
- Size 15/0 seed beads in 2 colors (less than 0.5g of each) - any brand
- 39ss (8mm) Preciosa Maxima Chatons - Qty: 2
- 25mm round Quick Link rings - Qty: 2
- Earwires
- Beading thread e.g. One-G, KO or FireLine, but have fun playing with color!

TOOLS

- Size 10 or 12 beading needle
- Scissors
- Synthetic wax

GETTING STARTED

Before we start it might be helpful to organize and label your beads like this:

- Delica – color 1 – A beads
- 15/0 – color 1 – B beads
- 15/0 – color 2 – C beads
- Delica – color 2 – D beads
- Deica – color 3 – E beads

STEP 1 - THE BEZEL

Working with a wingspan (1.5m) of toning beading thread (you can have fun with color here!) wax your thread well to help with stiffness. We will begin with a peyote bezel. (The video walks you through peyote).

Pick up 20 x Delicas (A beads) and join in a ring by passing through the first few beads again.

STEP 2

Next peyote 2 rows of Delicas (A beads) to create a band of 4 rows in total. You may find it easier to work this band around an awl or dowel to get the tension. (4 rows of Delicas in total).

STEP 3

Using 15/0 (B beads), peyote 1 round of 15/0s, keeping a firm tension to pull the bezel in. Pass through to the first row of Delicas.

STEP 4

Pop in the chaton, face up. This part can be a little fiddly. Peyote 1 row of 15/0s B beads on this side to draw the bezel in. You may need to manipulate the chaton and bezel with your fingers to secure the bezel neatly.

Reinforcing the final round of seed beads/Delicas can help hold the tension once the chaton is in place. Photo 1.

STEP 5

Once the bezel is secure, pass through to exit from a bead in Delica row 3 (from the front). You can weave in your tail thread at this point.

- A: Delica - DB-1132 Opaque Canary
- B: Miyuki 15/0 seed bead - 0406 Opaque Orange
- C: Miyuki 15/0 seed bead - 0404 Opaque Yellow
- D: Delica - DB-0161 Opaque Orange AB
- E: Delica - DB-1777 White-Lined Orange AB
- 39ss (8mm) Preciosa Maxima Chatons - Sun



BLURPLE

- A: Delica - DB-2510 Duracoat Galvanized Lilac Night
- B: Miyuki 15/0 seed bead - 0413 Opaque Light Blue
- C: Miyuki 15/0 seed bead - 0417L Opaque Periwinkle
- D: Delica - DB-2359 Duracoat Violet Blue
- E: Delica - DB-1783 White-Lined Capri Blue AB
- 39ss (8mm) Preciosa Maxima Chatons - Bermuda Blue
